Annual Reports to Parents Summer Term Assessment update Year 6



As we are coming towards the end of the academic year, you will soon be receiving your child's end of year report. We thought that we would take this opportunity to update and clarify the school's new reporting procedures to ensure you understand what the report means in terms of your child's attainment. For this year only, Year 6 children are to be assessed against a set of interim statements rather than all of the objectives on the grid. These teacher assessments will be recorded on the back page of the report. In addition, parents will be given their SATs results separately.

In Maths, your child is assessed according to the interim **age-related expectations** for Year 6. In order to have **met age-related expectations**, your child will have needed to have demonstrated an understanding of **all** of these required interim objectives. Our most able children will have mastered all of these objectives and will now be applying some of them at greater depth. However this will be recorded on the report as **met age-related expectations**. Children who have not shown evidence of meeting all of the interim age-related objectives, will

be reported as **not met**.

In English (Reading and Writing), your child is assessed according to interim age-related expectations for year In reading, in order to have **met** interim age-related expectations, your child will have demonstrated an understanding of each of these required objectives. Our most able children will have mastered all of these objectives and will now be

applying some of them at greater depth. However this will be recorded on the report as **met interim age-related expectations**. Children who have not shown enough evidence of the interim age-related objectives, will be reported as **not met**. In writing, your child will be assessed at whether they are working towards age-related expectations, met age-related expectations or working at greater depth.
