

Home Learning

Home Learning Reading Journals

- Children should read at home as often as possible.
- They should record their reading in their Home Reading Journals, 3 times a week.
- An adult should sign this weekly.
- Clear expectations and examples of what they could write about are inside their journal.



Spellings

- Spellings are set fortnightly
- Every other week, your child will come home with a list of spellings to learn for the following week
- Encourage your child to use their spelling words in conversation and in their writing
