What will we be doing in each subject?

In **E**nglish we will be writing short stories, diary entries and creating non-fiction pages.

In **S**cience we will be learning about light and electricity; making a variety of circuits, which will link closely with our **D**T this term.

In **C**omputing, we will be exploring programs involving control and simulation and creating hyperlinked presentations.

PE lessons will cover dance and gymnastics, as well as invasion games including tag rugby and hockey.

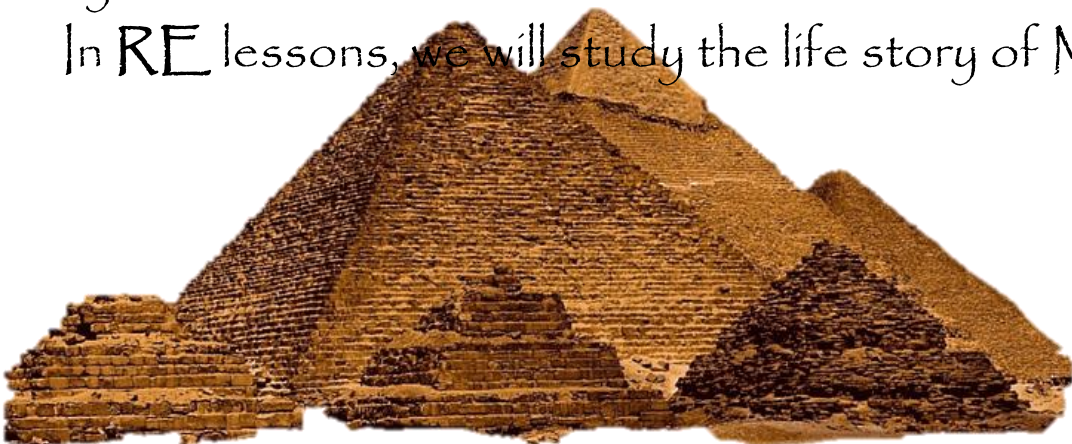
Art and **D**T lessons will focus on sculpting canopic jars from clay and creating **E**gyptian collars.

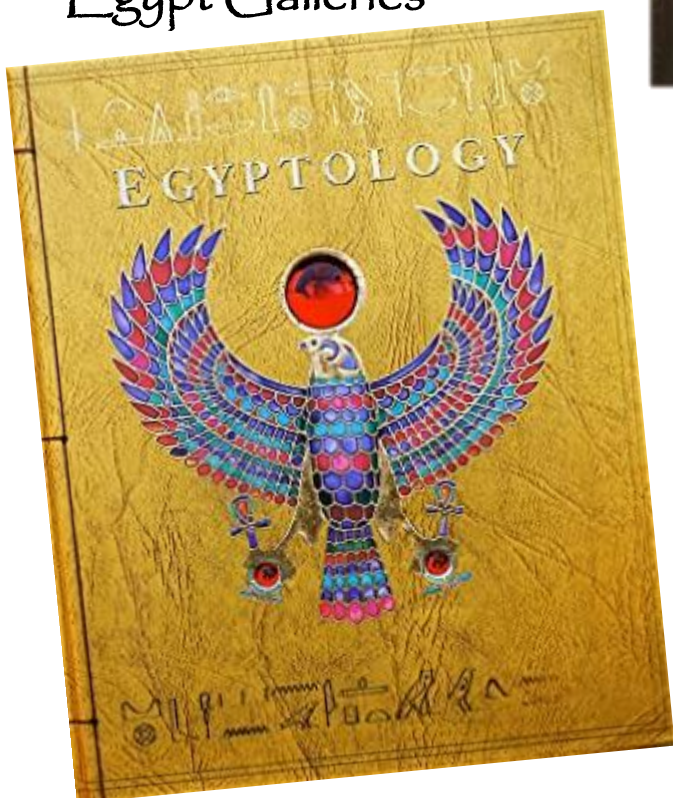
