

Home Learning

- Weekly English and Maths Homework from their CGP books will be given out on Wednesday and should be handed in on the following Wednesday.
- The date will be recoded in the contents page, next to the pages to be completed
- Homework should be completed to the same standard as expected in class.



Home Learning Reading Journals

- Children should read at home as often as possible.
- They should record their reading in their Home Reading Journals, 3 times a week.
- An adult should sign this weekly.
- Clear expectations and examples of what they could write about are inside their journal.



Spellings

- A list of spellings will be sent home every 2 weeks , to be learnt for a test the following week.



Maths Teaching

- Maths is taught in classes through a rotation.
- Each mixed ability group works with the teacher once a week and with a TA once a week.
