Expectations for reading

- Read **at least** 3 times a week at home
- Adults to support with reading when able to, especially with challenging texts
- Bring in reading records on **designated day** for us to see/check
- Ask questions to prompt understanding (including when you read to them)
- Children are encouraged to write in their own reading record a minimum of two times each week
- Adults should sign reading journals weekly



Spellings

A list of spellings will be sent home in homework books, a selection of these will then be tested every three weeks.
