# What's been going on



Year 4 recently experienced what life was like as a real-life Victorian servant at Preston Manor. As a writing stimulus, the children wrote persuasive job applications for 4 positions available at the manor house including: footman, fourth maid, odd man and kitchen maid. During the day, the interview included physical tasks similar to those undertaken by the servants (predominantly cleaning) and the best applicant for each role was ultimately given the job at the end of the session! This thrilling, immersive trip was unique and thoroughly enjoyable and the children will be using the experience to write a dilemma story in the coming weeks.



On Wednesday 7th November some children in **years 5 and 6** took part in the Indoor Athletics competition (against other local schools). All children involved were a credit to the school and participated well in their events. Southway did extremely well in both the field and track events and ended in **2nd place!**
