PRIORITY 1: Improve attainment and progress for all children in reading

We will ensure that we:

- Expose children to high quality texts guided reading (texts must be differentiated) / book corners / teachers' reading books
- * Make links with BH Library half term visits for all year groups
- * Ensure EAL comprehension is planned for Autumn term
- * Ensure Book Club focuses on PPM
- Use Clicker 7 to support SEN children
- Have a Rapid Readers programme
- Celebrate reading –develop further links between reading at home and school monthly book raffle & reading award
- Continue with Reading buddies / Adult readers
- Hold an Assembly in September to celebrate 'Summer Reading Challenge' newsletter photos / display board
- Plan author visits
- Celebrate World Book Day

PRIORITY 2: Improve attainment and progress for all children in

writing

We will ensure that we:

- * There is full coverage of the National Curriculum
- develop planning to ensure full coverage
- Children use their GPS / spelling patterns in writing across the curriculum by raising the profile in classrooms through use of washing lines
- monitor the quality of talking texts used
- * adapt the 'No Nonsense' spelling programme & provide CPD for staff
- * Train children to identify aspects of GPS and spelling patterns taught, in their writing
- Specifically teach children how to plan their writing, introducing 5 sentence plans for UK\$2 in story writing
- * Build children's stamina for writing by giving chn greater opportunities for extended writing
- * Plan in more opportunities for choice & independence in children's writing
- * Train children to proof read their writing for spelling and for sense
- * Ensure verbal rehearsal for LA & SEN children
- Reduce talk for writing in Y5&Y6
- Further develop washing lines in classrooms to signpost learning

PRIORITY 3: Improve attainment and progress for all children in maths

- We will ensure that we:
- Will make use of Abacus books in rotation maths
- Run a Problem Solving Day per term
- Further develop teachers' understanding of verbal and written reasoning through CPD training
- Have mixed ability single gender groups
- Trial single gender groupings for targeted booster sessions in Y4
- MSL monitors classes during L&M to demonstrate guided maths group in mixed abilities
- Increase the use of practical equipment in Y3/4
- Develop children's understanding of verbal and written reasoning:
- Use Sentence starters for appropriate lessons
- Use Abacus Y1 & Y2 books to support LA and SEN children
- Utilise 'Number Shark' more for pre KS2 children
- Use Twinkle Assessments little & often testing
- * Carry out Year team moderations
- Carry out Whole school moderations
- Participate in external moderations
- Introduce a weekly Maths club
- Ensure Sports Week incorporates maths
- Provide Times tables challenge / Awards every term
