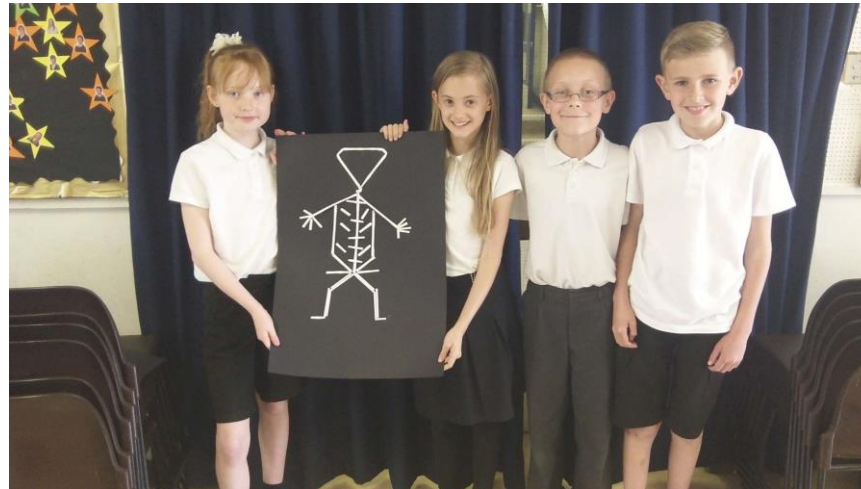

- Parents will be contacted for both positive and negative behaviour

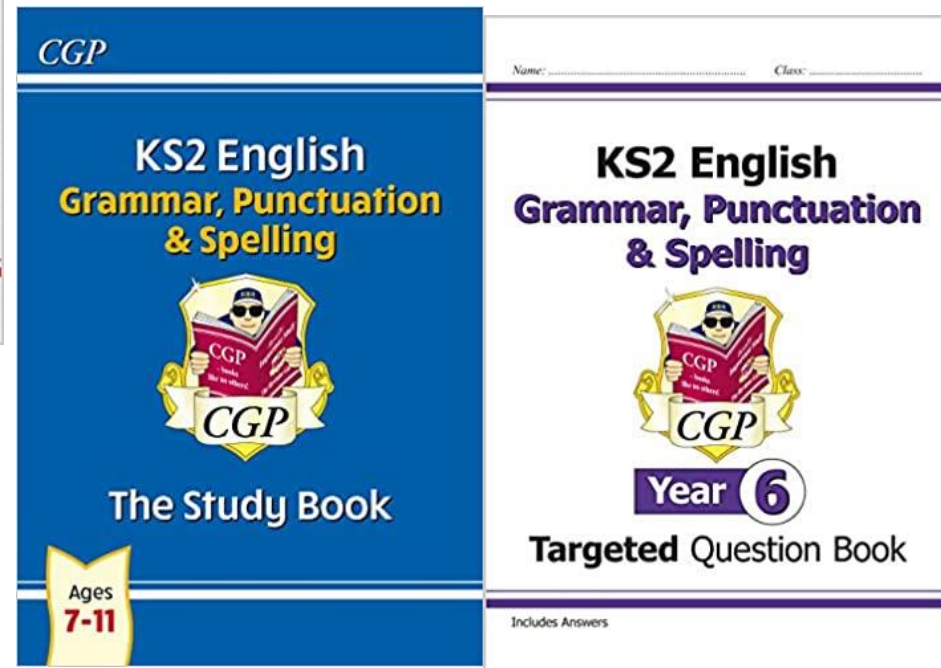
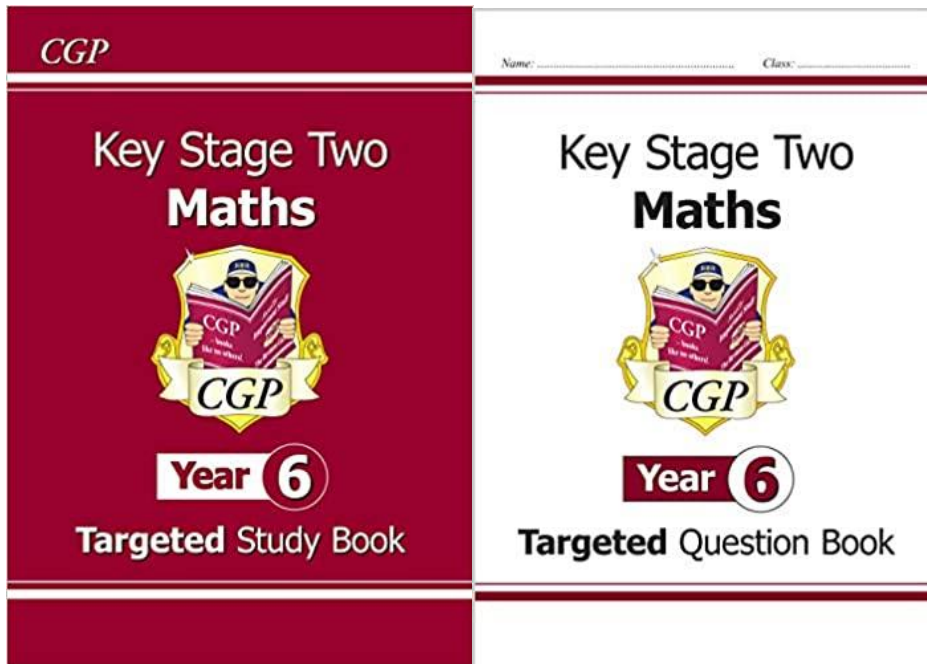


Home Learning

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Home Learning Reading Journals

- Children should read at home as often as possible.
- They should record 3 comments in their home reading journals per week.
- Comments must be written on different days.
- Each week, your child will be given a specific 'VIPERS' to base their next comment on.
- Clear expectations and examples of what they could write about are inside their journal.




Spellings

- Spellings are set weekly
- Every week, your child will come home with a list of spellings to learn for the following week
- Encourage your child to use their spelling words in conversation and in their writing



Spellings Strategies

Your child will be given a double sided A4 sheet of spelling strategies to help support them learning their spellings at home.

Drawing an image around the word	<p>This strategy is all about making a word memorable. It links to meaning in order to try to make the spelling noticeable.</p>  <p>You can't use this method as your main method of learning spellings, but it might work on those that are just a little more difficult to remember.</p>
Words without vowels	<p>This strategy is useful where the vowel choices are the challenge in the words. Write the words without the vowels and pupils have to choose the correct grapheme to put in the space. For example, for the word field:</p> <p>f_____ld</p>
Pyramid words	<p>This method of learning words forces you to think of each letter separately.</p> <p>p py pyr pyra pyram pyrami pyramid</p> <p>You can then reverse the process so that you end up with a diamond.</p>
