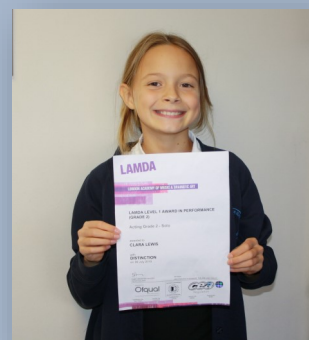


Vincent from Shakespeare Class took part in a Super Hero Triathlon. He had to swim 150m, cycle 3k & run 1k. Well done Vincent!
