I am delighted to tell you that we have had a substantial amount of improvement work carried out over the summer holiday and it is still ongoing. As you will see from the photos, Chris, our mural man, has been busy again and we now have a brilliant south coast mural on the main playground, as well as an amazing under sea world in our Y3 undercover area. Chris will be returning in January to create a mountain range scene in the Y5/6 entrance, a large map of Great Britain and a school logo at the front of the school.

All of our classrooms have also had bespoke cupboards, sinks and tap ware fitted, with matching splash backs. Our PE shed has now been thoroughly kitted out with over £2000 of new equipment and storage.

Future works include the arrival of a life sized Pterodactyl, a 3m tall replica of Saturn V and a scaled model of the Wright Brothers 'Kitty Hawk' (to be hung in the Y6 stairwell).
